Topic: **Systems in place to accommodate submission of Employers' Return (Form 2A)**

The Commissioner-General of the Guyana Revenue Authority (GRA) Mr. Khurshid Sattaur wishes to inform the General Public that GRA in keeping with its mandate to ensure voluntary compliance, have put systems in place to ensure that persons can submit their Form 2A over the weekend.

While Taxpayers have responded positively so far, it is estimated that a large number of Returns are still outstanding. The statutory deadline is Sunday, February 28 and in an effort to accommodate persons who were unable to submit their returns during the normal working hours, a box will be placed at the Albert Street entrance of GRA's Office, 210 'E' Albert & Charlotte Streets Bourda.

Employers are reminded that the Taxpayer Identification Number for each employee must be stated on the form along with their name, address, period worked, total income and total tax deducted.

Other information that should be included are; the sequential number (column 1), whether the employee was wholly or partly employed for the period and any other allowances in kind received by the employee.

All returns must be accompanied by a signed declaration and persons submitting electronic copies of the Form 2A are also required to submit the hard copy.
